


Change in Action

Inform teachers and leaders

about the problem and solution

Recognize and define the specific issue





Establish clear usage guidelines for teachers and students

Intentionally plan teacher and leader learning opportunities on the product and pedagogy

Provide Professional Learning





Follow Up and Incentivize

Monitor usage and reward participation

Identify teachers and leaders who can share their experiences

Find Models of Practice





Analyze data to identify areas for growth









Modify strategies based on evolving needs

Reiterate the process annually due to staffing changes
